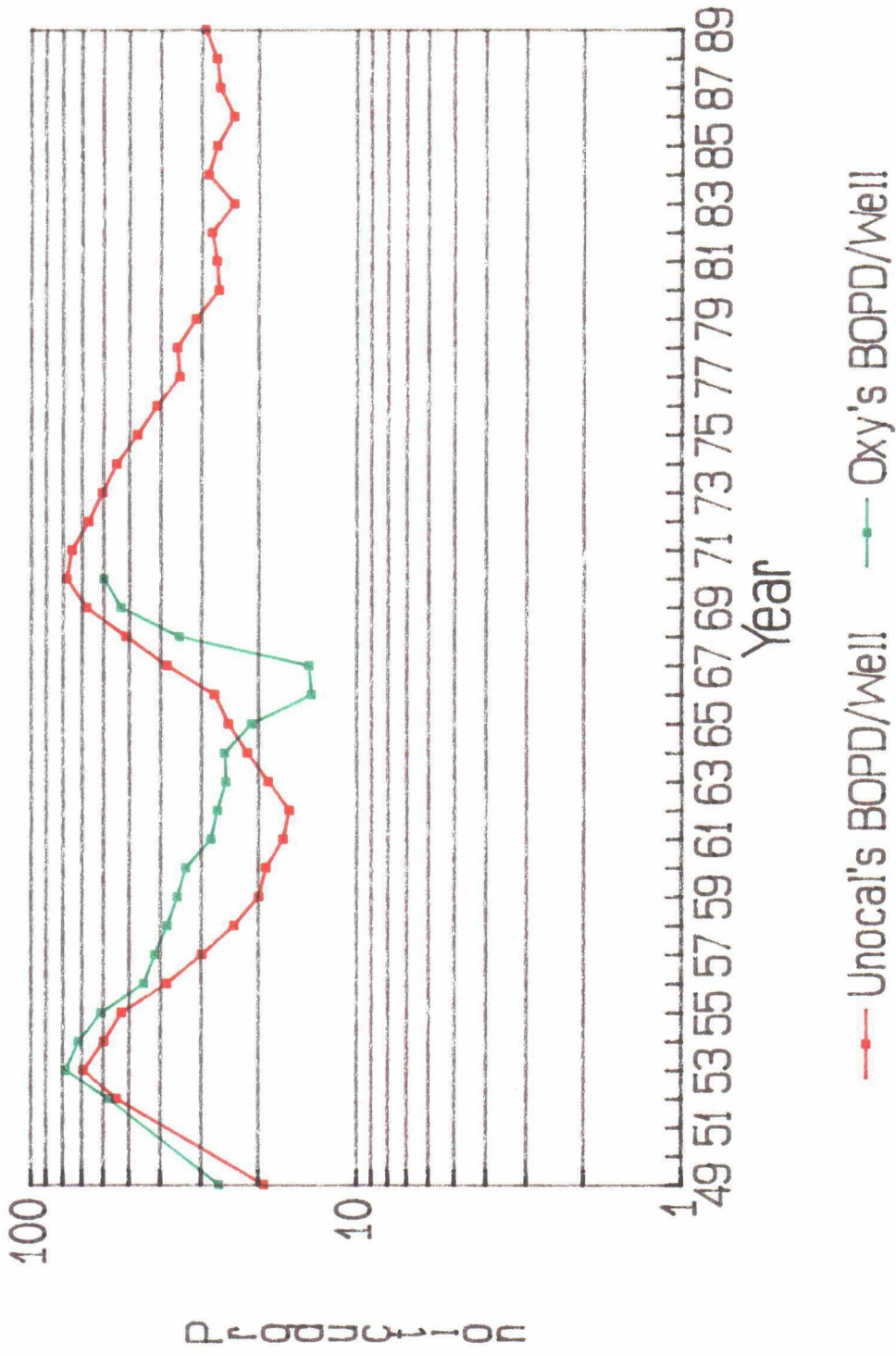
Production Plot



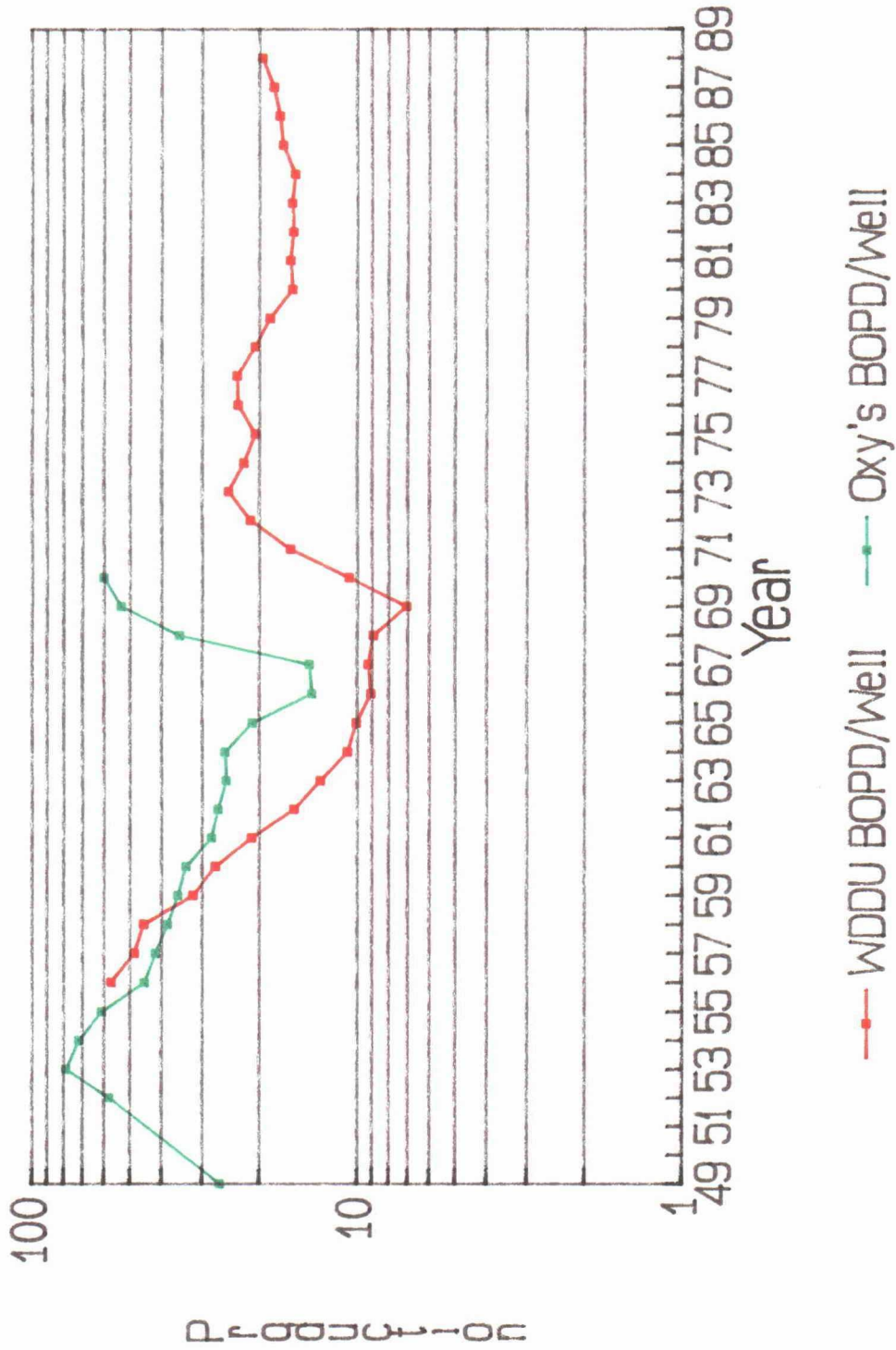


Gentlemen:




