COMES NOW, MARATHON OIL COMPANY, by and through its attorneys, Kellahin, Kellahin & Aubrey, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a Special Oil Allowable for the Tamano Bone Springs Oil Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, as more specifically described as follows:

- 1. By Order R-7958, dated July 1, 1985, the Division created the Tamano Bone Springs Oil Pool, whose vertical limits encompass the entire Bone Springs formation and whose current horizontal limits comprise the S/2 Section 2; all of Section 11; SW/4 Section 12 and the W/2 of Section 14, T18S, R31E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 2. Applicant is the operator of ten currently producing wells in the Pool.

- 3. The location of the wells in the Pool is as set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto.
- 4. There are currently sixteen wells completed in and producing from the Pool of which a top unit allowable for the Pool on statewide rules allows for production not in excess of 230 barrels of oil per day at a GOR of 2,000 to 1.
- 5. Applicant seeks authority to operate wells in the Pool at twice the current maximum allowable or a maximum daily rate not in excess of 460 BOPD.
- 6. The names and addresses of the Operators in the Pool to whom notice has been sent by a copy of this Application are set forth on Exhibit B to this Application.
- 7. That the proposed Special Allowable is necessary in order to meet market demand and will not be in excess of the most efficient rate of production for the proper development and depletion of the pool thereby preventing waste and protecting correlative rights.
- 8. Applicant requests that this Application be set for hearing on the Examiner's docket now scheduled for October 17, 1990.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this Application be set for hearing and that after notice and hearing the Application be granted as requested.


