4. The approval of this Application is in the interest of conservation and will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

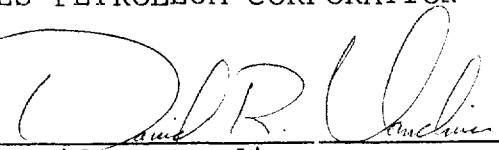
WHEREFORE, Applicant prays:
