## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That Paragraph (2) on Page 1 of Order No. R-7553 be and the same is hereby corrected to read as follows:
  - "(2) That the applicant, OGR Operating Company, Inc., seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian formations (gas pools only) underlying the E/2 of Section 17, Township 16 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico."
- (2) That Paragraph (1) on Page 3 of Order No. R-7553 be and the same is hereby corrected to read as follows:
  - "(1) That all mineral interests, whatever they may be, in the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian formations (gas pools only) underlying the E/2 of Section 17, Township 16 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, are hereby pooled to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit to be dedicated to a well to be drilled at a standard location thereon."

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(3) That the correction set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of June 14, 1984.
