Township 19 North, Range 30 East, NMPM

All of Sections 30, 31 and 32

Township 18 North, Range 30 East, NMPM

All of Sections 6 and 7
All of Sections 16 through 20
All of Sections 29 and 30

Applicant further requests well locations of not less than 1650 feet to the outer boundary of each section and no nearer than 330 feet to any governmental quarter-quarter section line.
