

1. Applicant is the operator of the SW/4, S/2 NW/4, W/2 SE/4 of Section 13, Township 12 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico, which contains a total of 320 acres.

2. Applicant seeks the establishment of a non-standard proration unit to be comprised of the above-referenced acreage in the Morrow Formation to be dedicated to its State 13 Well No. 1 located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 13.


3. Granting the application will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.
