Application for Extension Gavilan-Mancos Oil Pool Rio Arriba Co., New Mexico Case 8331

Amoco Production Company hereby makes application for extension of the Gavilan-Mancos Oil Pool, Rio Arriba Co., New Mexico to include Sections 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23 and 24-T24N-R2W.

In support of this application the following facts are presented:

1. By order No. R-7407 dated March 1, 1984 the Commission established the Gavilan-Mancos Oil Pool as follows:

Township 24N-Range 2W, NMPM Sections 1 through 3: All

Township 25N-Range 2W, NMPM Sections 19 through 30: All Sections 33 through 36: All

- 2. Amoco Production Company has drilled and is now completing the Amoco Federal OSO Canyon Well No. 1, 1650' FNL, 990'FWL, Sec. 24-T24N-R2W, Rio Arriba Co., New Mexico.
- 3. Information gained from the drilling of this well indicates the characteristics of the Mancos formation are similar to those encountered within the presently defined Gavilan-Mancos Oil Pool and that pool should be expanded to include the following area:

Township 24N-Range 2W, NMPM Sections 10 through 14: All

Sections 23 and 24: All

4. Amoco is the owner of Mancos working interest rights under the lands proposed in (3) above and has plans for further development drilling in that area.

Extension of the temporary special Rules and Regulations for the Gavilan-Mancos Oil Pool as proposed herein would prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent reduced recovery of hydrocarbons which might result from the drilling of too many wells and otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights. We respectfully request this matter be set for hearing at the earliest possible date.
