Santa Fe Energy Company hereby makes application for approval of an unorthodox gas well location in the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 25, Township 22 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant has the right to drill a well in the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 25, Township 22 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.
2. Applicant seeks approval to drill a gas well at an unorthodox location 660 feet from the west line and 990 feet from the north line of the section to test the Morrow, Strawn, and Wolfcamp formations. Applicant is currently seeking administrative approval of this unorthodox location, but desires that this case be heard as soon as possible if administrative approval is not granted.
3. The $W\frac{1}{2}$ of the section is to be dedicated to the well.
4. Approval of this application will be in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.
