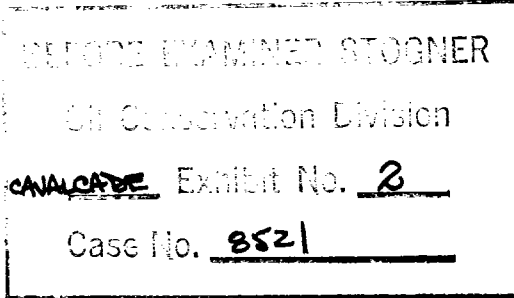

At your request, I have examined Hervey, Dow & Hinkle Title Opinion No. 10,354, dated April 6, 1950, and Elliott & Waldron Title and Abstract Co., Inc. supplemental abstract No. 85-275, which collectively reflect all instruments filed of record in Lea County, New Mexico, affecting fee simple title to the above described lands, for the time period from inception of records down to March 8, 1985 at 7:00 A.M.
