Comes now, M & W OF LOVINGTON, INC., by and through its undersigned attorneys and applies to the Oil Conservation Division for an order amending previously promulgated Division Order No. R-3616 approving the disposal of salt water located in Unit L of Section 16, Township 8 South, Range 36 East, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, South Prairie-Cisco Pool. In support of its application, M & W of Lovington, Inc. would show:

- 1. Applicant is the operator of the O'Neill State Well No. l in the South Prairie-Cisco Pool, in Roosevelt County, New Mexico.
- 2. The applicant proposes to utilize said well to dispose of produced salt water into all formations below a packer set at 4100 feet pursuant to previously issued Division Order No. R-3616.
- 3. That approval of the subject application will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells and otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays this application be set for hearing on September 11, 1985, before a duly appointed Examiner and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Divisior enter its order amending Order No. R-3616 approving the salt water disposal well.
