SUBJECT: CASE No. 8834 -- Application of Cities Service Oil & Gas Corporation for pool creation, special pool rules and discovery allowable.

Cities Service Elkan A Well #1-L located in Section 25, T13S, R34E, has been completed in the Bough "C" or Upper Pennsylvanian. Following standard policy this well would normally be placed in the nearest Upper Pennsylvanian pool which is the Cerca Upper Pennsylvanian Pool. It should be pointed out that Cities Service is 1.19 miles from the nearest boundary of the Cerca Upper Pennsylvanian Pool and in accordance with General Rule 104.A this well is properly classified as a wildcat well. Also, the production in Cerca Upper Pennsylvanian Pool is from the Bough "A" zone in the Upper Pennsylvanian. However, according to nomenclature, the Cerca Upper Pennsylvanian Pool includes the Bough "A", "B", "C" and "D" zones.

I do not object or support this case and I will accept the decision of the examiner. If it is decided to create a new pool, the new pool should be created with the SW/4 of Section 25 dedicated to the new pool.
