APPLICATION OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Exxon Corporation hereby applies for an order approving a change in the orientation of a spacing unit and an orthodox gas well location, Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the Mary Federal Well No. 1 located 1924 feet from the North line and 651 feet from the East line of Section 11, Township 23 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, in the Sheep Draw - Strawn Gas Pool.

2. The Mary Federal Well No. 1 unit currently comprises the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 11.

3. Applicant seeks to have the orientation of the Mary Federal Well No. 1 unit changed from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ to the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 11, with simultaneous approval of the resultant unorthodox gas well location.

4. Approval of this application will be in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.
