This letter confirms our discussion of October 2, in which I advised you that a meeting had been held between Perry Pearce, Frank Douglas, Tom Kellahin and myself concerning certain hearings on the Gavilan area currently scheduled for October 15. The purpose of this meeting was to see if we could identify areas of agreement between the parties and eliminate certain disputes between Mallon, Greer, Dugan and Sun, thereby reducing the matters that we would need to ask the Commission to resolve. No real agreements were reached at that time, but we have agreed to continue exploration of possible avenues of settlement of the disputes between the parties.


In this regard, you should be advised that Mr. Greer has concluded that the Mancos reservoir in this area has deteriorated to such a point that his application for an additional period of time within which to make up accumulated underproduction for his E-6 Well is no longer meaningful and therefore, he hereby requests that Case 8951 be dismissed.

We also request the October 15th hearing in Case 9111 for expansion of the BMG West Puerto Chiquito-Mancos Pressure Maintenance Project Area be continued and rescheduled for hearing during December, 1987.

Neither Mr. Pearce nor Mr. Kellahin oppose this requested continuance.

The subject case was heard before the Commission on October 24, 1986, at which time testimony was presented showing the need for a 12 month period to make up accumulated underproduction for certain wells which were shut-in during a long-term reservoir pressure test conducted in the Mancos formation (test authorized by Order No. R-8124). The Commission then continued this case for the Commission Hearing in March 1987 or "in another hearing which might be convened before that time".

The applicant in this matter, Al Greer, has requested this case be continued to the examiner hearing scheduled for March 18, 1987. In reviewing the record on this matter, I find it to be in the best interest to all concerned if the case were continued at the Division level. Therefore, Commission Case No. 8951 is hereby continued to the March 18, 1987 Examiner's Hearing.

Dear Mr. LeMay:

As you are aware, the above-referenced case was continued following a Commission hearing on October 24, 1986 "...until the Gavilan case should be reopened, either at the March, 1987, Commission Hearing, or in another hearing which might be convened before that time,...". I have discovered this morning that this case may be set for hearing before a Division Examiner on March 18, 1987.

I am concerned that if the case is reopened on March 18, 1987, it will result in a de novo hearing before an examiner following a Commission Hearing, a proceeding which is, perhaps, outside the rules of the Division. I am also concerned that, inasmuch as the case was continued by the Commission as noted above, to reopen the matter on March 18 may create notice problems which could be raised at a later date to challenge any Order resulting from the March 18 hearing.

On behalf of Benson-Montin-Greer Drilling Corporation, I, therefore, request that the case not be advertised for hearing on March 18, 1987, that the case be reopened at the March 30, 1987 Commission Hearing and at that time be continued to another date. I believe that this approach would be consistent with the previous ruling of the Commission and with what is apparently the Commission's intention of not hearing this matter in conjunction with other cases scheduled for March 30.


