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3 1 2 MR. STOGNER: We'll call next 3 Case Number 8956. MR. TAYLOR: Application of 5 Energy Corporation for an unorthodox oil well location, Chaves County, New Mexico. 7 MR. Call STOGNER: for 8 appearances. 9 MR. CARSON: Mr. Examiner, my 10 name is Joel Carson, Losee & Carson, P. A., Artesia, New 11 Mexico, appearing on behalf of the applicant and I will have 12 one witness. 13 MR. STOGNER: Are there any 14 other apperances? 15 There being none, will the 16 witness please stand and be sworn. 17 18 (Witness sworn.) 19 20 STEVEN A. JENSEN, 21 being called as a witness and being duly sworn upon his 22

oath, testified as follows, to-wit:

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## 1 DIRECT EXAMINATION 2 BY MR. CARSON: 3 Would you state your name, please? Q My name is Steven A. Jensen. Α 5 Mr. Jenson, by whom are you employed? 6 I'm employed by Cibola Energy Corpor-Α 7 ation. 8 And in what capacity? Q 9 I'm a geophysicist. Α 10 Have you ever testified before the 11 Consrvation Division before? 12 No, I haven't. 13 Would you tell the Examiner a little 14 about your educational and experience and qualifications? 15 I got a Bachelor of Science degree 16 geophysical engineering from Colorado School of Mines. 17 worked for Geophysical Services, International, in Saudi 18 Arabia for two and a half years. 19 I worked for Union Oil Company of Cali-20 fornia in Oklahoma for two years, and I have been working 21 for Cibola Energy Corporation in New Mexico for two years. 22 0 Are you acquainted with the area which 23 this -- to which this application is related? 24 Α Yes, sir. 25

1 witness as an expert, Mr. Examiner. MR. STOGNER: Mr. Jensen is so qualified. Now, Mr. Jensen, would you explain brief-5 ly the purpose of this application? Α Cibola Energy Corporation's application 7 to drill an unorthodox oil well location in Chaves Coun-8 ty, New Mexico. 9 And you're proposing to drill this Hadley 10 1 Well 2290 feet from the north line and 1200 feet from No. 11 the east line of Section 36, Township 10 South, Range 12 East, in the Wildcate Devonian Pool located in the 13 southeast/northeast of Section 36, is that correct? 14 That's correct. 15 I will refer you to what we've marked as Q 16 Applicant's Exhibit Number One, Mr. Jensen, and ask if that 17 exhibit was prepared by you or under your supervision? 18 Yes, it was. 19 Would you tell the Examiner what 0 that 20 purports to show? 21 The map shows the -- in red is the State Α 22 lease purchased by Cibola Energy Corporation and the green 23 lease in Section 31 is -- most of it is leased by Cibola. 24 So Cibola is the lessee and owns 100 per-25

cent of the working interest on that area designated in red

6 1 and the State owns the royalty, is that correct? 2 Α Correct. 3 And you're seeking to move unorthodoxly to the west, is that correct? 5 Correct, 130 feet, approximately. 6 Now, let's look at Applicant's Exhibit 7 Number Two. 8 Would you -- was that exhibit prepared by you or under your supervision? 10 Yes, it was. 11 Would you tell the Examiner what that ex-12 hibit is and what it purports to show? 13 Α The exhibit is a structure map on top of 14 the Mississippian limestone, using two seismic lines. 15 There's a north/south line and an east/west line. 16 And what -- what does it show? 17 Α The Mississippi limestone structure shows 18 a rollover into a fault and we propose drilling on top of 19 the structure. 20 And the proposed location, unorthodox lo-21 cation is the ideal place to drill. 22 Α Yes, it is. 23 You've made some calculations, have you 24 not, as to possible losses if -- in the event that you're 25 not permitted to drill in that location?

7 1 The dot, the red dot just Α Yes, I have. the east of the proposed location would be an orthodox location and the map shows that we will lose approximately 10 feet of structure and approximately 10 acres of effective 5 drainage. 6 Using volumetric equation, I computed we 7 will lose an estimated 37,000 barrels of oil. 8 0 And that, those calculations are showed 9 on the Applicant's Exhibit Number Three, is that correct? 10 Correct. 11 MR. CARSON: I would like to 12 move the introduction of Applicant's Exhibits Number One 13 through Three, Mr. Examiner. 14 MR. STOGNER: Exhibits One 15 through Three will be admitted into evidence. 16 Mr. Jensen, in your professional opinion 17 will the granting of this application protect correlative 18 rights, prevent waste and otherwise prevent drainage and 19 otherwise prevent the drilling of an unnecessary number of 20 wells? 21 Α Yes, sir. 22 MR. CARSON: I don't have any 23 further questions.

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#### CROSS EXAMINATION

3 BY MR. STOGNER:

Q Mr. Jensen, referring to Exhibit Number

Two, is this information all -- comes from geophysical work?

A Yes, sir. The two seismic lines control the prospect.

On the second page of Exhibit Number One, which you show, is the leasehold rights common throughout Section 36?

A Yes, sir, to my knowledge the State of New Mexico owns the section and we have the mineral rights on it.

(There followed a discussion off the record.)

MR. CARSON: That was our understanding, Mr. Examiner, that the notice only had to go to those people that we were moving unorthodoxly towards and that's really ourselves.

MR. STOGNER: And that's yourself. Okay, that's what I was wanting to get out.

MR. TAYLOR: In what manner is

this location unorthodox?

9 1 MR. CARSON: It's moving towards 2 the quarter quarter line. 3 Is that orthodox MR. TAYLOR: by virtue of being located closer to the outer boundary of 5 the unit? 6 STOGNER: Well, yeah, it's MR. 7 a 40-acre oil unit. 8 It's a 40-acre proration unit. 9 MR. TAYLOR: So any owner of an 10 undrilled lease which adjoins the applicant's spacing unit 11 on one or more of the two sides of a single corner closest 12 to the proposed well is --13 MR. CARSON: That's us. 14 MR. STOGNER: Okay. All right, 15 got that all taken care of. 16 I have no further questions of 17 Mr. Jensen on this. 18 Are there any other questions 19 of this witness? 20 If not, he may be excused. 21 Mr. Carson, do you have any-22 thing further in this case? 23 MR. CARSON: Nothing further, 24 Mr. Examiner. 25 MR. STOGNER: Case Number 8956 will be taken under advisement.
