order of the Division,

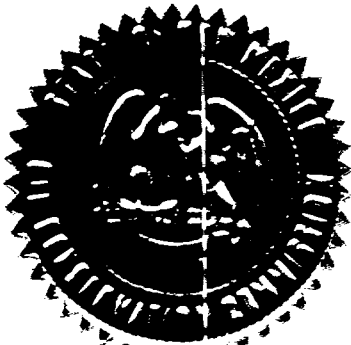
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Ordering Paragraph No. (1) on page 2 of said Order  
No. R-8283 is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as  
follows:

"(1) The application of Tenneco Oil Company  
for an unorthodox oil well location for the Undesignated  
Ranger Lake-Pennsylvanian Pool is hereby approved  
for a well to be located at a point 330 feet from the  
North line and 2310 feet from the East line (Unit B)  
of Section 24, Township 12 South, Range 34 East, NMPM,  
Lea County, New Mexico."
