
Dear Mr. LeMay:

On behalf of Sage Energy Company, we request that the above referenced DeNovo hearing now set for a Commission hearing on July 16, 1987, be continued indefinitely while Sage Energy Company goes forward with its proposal for a pilot waterflood project in the same area. The pilot waterflood project is now pending a hearing on the July 29, 1987, Examiner's docket as Case 9182.
