Parrish "IV" Com. No. 1 Well, T19S, R25E, NMPU, Section 19, SE/4, Eddy County, New Mexico

Please refer to Mr. Dickerson's letter dated January 15, 1987, and the request for Hearing attached wherein he stated that Yates Petroleum Corporation is planning to seek compulsory pooling for the subject well. Conoco Inc., as a working interest owner, has already approved the AFE for their share of costs for drilling this well.

Please be advised that Conoco is now in the process of negotiating the purchase of Amoco Production Company's working interest in the subject well and also certain other properties in the area. We expect this purchase to be finalized within a month. Conoco will then commit to paying that additional share of the drilling and related costs upon submission of an amended AFE by Yates.

We therefore respectfully request that you dismiss the compulsory pooling case as it pertains to Amoco. In the alternative, we would request that the Examiner Hearing be continued for one month to allow time for our purchase of Amoco's interest to be finalized. We believe that the above will save a great deal of trouble and considerable expense for both Yates and Conoco.

By copy of this letter to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, and in the event that you do not elect to dismiss the Hearing, we request that the NMOCD re-schedule the Hearing for March 4, 1987. We believe that by that time forced pooling will not be necessary.

We would appreciate your consideration of this request and a reply at your earliest convenience.
