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A This is a schematic plat of the north half of Section 9, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, that shows the tracts covered by C and E leases and by Beta Development Company leases, with the exception of the area down there in the old town site that we covered in the Exhibit One.

All right, sir. Now let me direct your attention to Exhibit Number Three and have you identify that for us.

A These are the names and addresses of the parties who own interests in the north half of Section 9, to whom pooling notices have been sent.

Q And how was that information tabulated, Mr. Carr?

- A You mean the --
- Q What's the source of the information?
- A -- acreage information?
  - No, sir, what's the source of the names?
  - A Is the computer printout of the -- furnished by the tax assessor's office, of the people's current addresses as far as receiving tax notices.

All right, sir, and the last page of that exhibit contains a tabulation?

A Yes, it shows the acreage involved in the various leased and unleased tracts and their percentage

in the unit.

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All right. Let me refer you to Exhibit
Number Four and have you identify that exhibit.

Exhibit Number Four is an AFE for the drilling of one of the wells which we have staked on this unit, which we designate as the Fee No. 9-A, and it covers the drilling and completion of a dual Mesaverde-Platales.

Cliff well.

The well to be drilled on the north half of Section 2 is to be a dual Pictured Cliff-Mesaverde well?

A. Yes, sir.

Your application seeks only a compulsory pooling order on the Mesaverde formation. That's true, is it not?

That's true. The Pictured Cliff formation is already the subject of prior pooling and is held by current Pictured Cliff production.

What is the total cost estimated for the dually completed well?

A \$399,037.

All right. Now, subsequent in your testimony we have another exhibit that discusses how you propose to allocate the costs of the dually completed well to the nonconsenting owners of the Mesaverde rights.
