## APPLICATION

El Aquitaine Petroleum, a division of Elf Aquitaine, Inc., hereby applies for approval of a horizontal directionally drilled well and for special provisions relating to such wells within a portion of the Chacon-Dakota Associated Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

- 1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the  $W^{\frac{1}{2}}$  of Section 14, Township 23 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
- 2. The W½ of Section 14 is located within the Chacon-Dakota Associated Pool.
- 3. The special rules and regulations of the Chacon-Dakota Associated Pool, Order No. R-5353-B, provide for 160 acre oil well spacing and 320 gas well spacing, and further provide that said pool is governed by the general rules and regulations for associated oil and gas pools promulgated by Order No. R-5353.
- 4. The No. 2 Well is located in the  $NW_4^1NW_4^1$  of Section 14 and has the  $NW_4^1$  of Section 14 dedicated to it. Said well is currently near depletion.

- 5. The \_\_\_\_\_\_ No. 6 Well is located in the SW\square SW\square of Section 14 and has the SW\square of Section 14 dedicated to it. Said well is currently shut-in.
- 6. Applicant seeks approval to re-enter the No. 2 Well and directionally drill horizontally through the Dakota formation, in a southeasterly direction. The perforations in the horizontal portion of the well bore will be located in both the  $NW_4^1$  and  $SW_4^1$  of Section 14.
- 7. Applicant seeks special provisions for the  $W^{1}_{2}$  of Section 14, within the Chacon-Dakota Associated Pool, for horizontal directionally drilled wells, including:
  - (a) Permission to dedicate two 160 acre units to one well. In particular, the SW4 and NW4 will be dedicated to the \_\_\_\_\_ No. 2 Well.
  - (b) Relief from the orthodox well location requirements or Order No. R-5353. Specifically, applicant requests that a horizontal directionally drilled well not be considered unorthodox so long as the well perforations are no closer than 790 330' feet from the outer boundary of the W½ of Section 14.
  - (c) An oil well allowable based upon a 320 acre unit.
- 8. The matters urged herein by applicant are in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.
