



Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that Nearburg Producing Company has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking a non-standard proration unit consisting of Lot 4 (SW/4 SW/4) of Section 19, Township 16 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. Nearburg Producing Company proposes to dedicate the non-standard proration unit to its Soledad 19 Well #1 located at an unorthodox location 1000 feet from the South and West lines of said Section 19. Nearburg Producing Company also seeks approval of the well's unorthodox location in the Strawn formation, Northeast Lovington Penn Pool.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on February 17, 1988. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be subject to the non-standard proration unit or affected by the unorthodox well location, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.




