NEARBURG PRODUCING COMPANY, by and through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for approval of an unorthodox gas well location, and in support thereof would show the Division:

1. Applicant is the operator of the N/2 of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico and proposes to drill the Genecco 14 D Well No. 1 at a point 660 feet from the North and West lines of said Section 14.

2. Applicant seeks an exception to the well location requirements of Oil Conservation Division Rule 104 to permit the drilling of the well at the above described unorthodox location to a depth sufficient to adequately test the Morrow formation, Undesignated Cemetary-Morrow Pool.


3. That approval of this application will afford applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of hydrocarbons underlying this spacing unit and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.



NEARBURG PRODUCING COMPANY, by and through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for approval of an unorthodox gas well location and amendment of Division Order No. R-6933, and in support thereof would show the Division:

1. By Order No. R-6933 (Case 7522) the Division approved an unorthodox well location for a well to be drilled 660 feet from the North and West lines of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

2. That a well was commenced at this location in 1982, but not completed.

3. Subsequent to the entry of the prior Order approving this unorthodox location, the ownership of the offsetting acreage has changed with Nearburg Producing Company now being the offsetting owner.

4. Nearburg is now the operator of the N/2 of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico and proposes to drill the Genecco 14 D Well No. 1 at a point 660 feet from the North and West lines of said Section 14.

5. Applicant seeks an exception to the well location requirements of Oil Conservation Division Rule 104 to permit the drilling of the well at the above described unorthodox location to a depth sufficient to adequately test the Morrow formation, Undesignated Cemetary-Morrow Pool.


