APPLICATION

Read & Stevens, Inc. hereby applies for approval of an unorthodox gas well location, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant has the right to drill a well in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 19, Township 19 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location for a well to be drilled at a point 660 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the east line in Section 19, to test the Morrow formation.

3. The E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 19 is to be dedicated to the well.

4. All offset operators have been properly notified of the proposed unorthodox location.

5. Approval of the requested unorthodox well location will be in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.

6. Applicant requests that this matter be heard at the April 13, 1988 Examiner hearing.

WHEREFORE, applicant respectfully requests that an order be entered approving the above-identified unorthodox well location.
