APPLICATION

Comes now Leonard Resource Corporation through its attorneys and respectfully requests approval of an unorthodox gas well location, Eddy County, New Mexico and in support thereof, states as follows:

1. Applicant is an operator with interests underlying N $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 24, Township 26 South, Range 24 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.
2. Applicant wishes to drill its wildcat Broken Arrow Unit #24-1 Well to an objective depth in the Pennsylvanian Morrow formation at approximately 8,700 feet beneath the surface. Said well is to be drilled at a location 510 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 24.
3. Applicant proposes to dedicate said N $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 24 to said well.
4. A well at said unorthodox location will better enable the Applicant to produce gas underlying the proration unit.
5. Approval of the unorthodox location will be in the interests of conservation, prevention of waste and protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this case be set for an examiner's hearing on the July 20, 1988 docket.

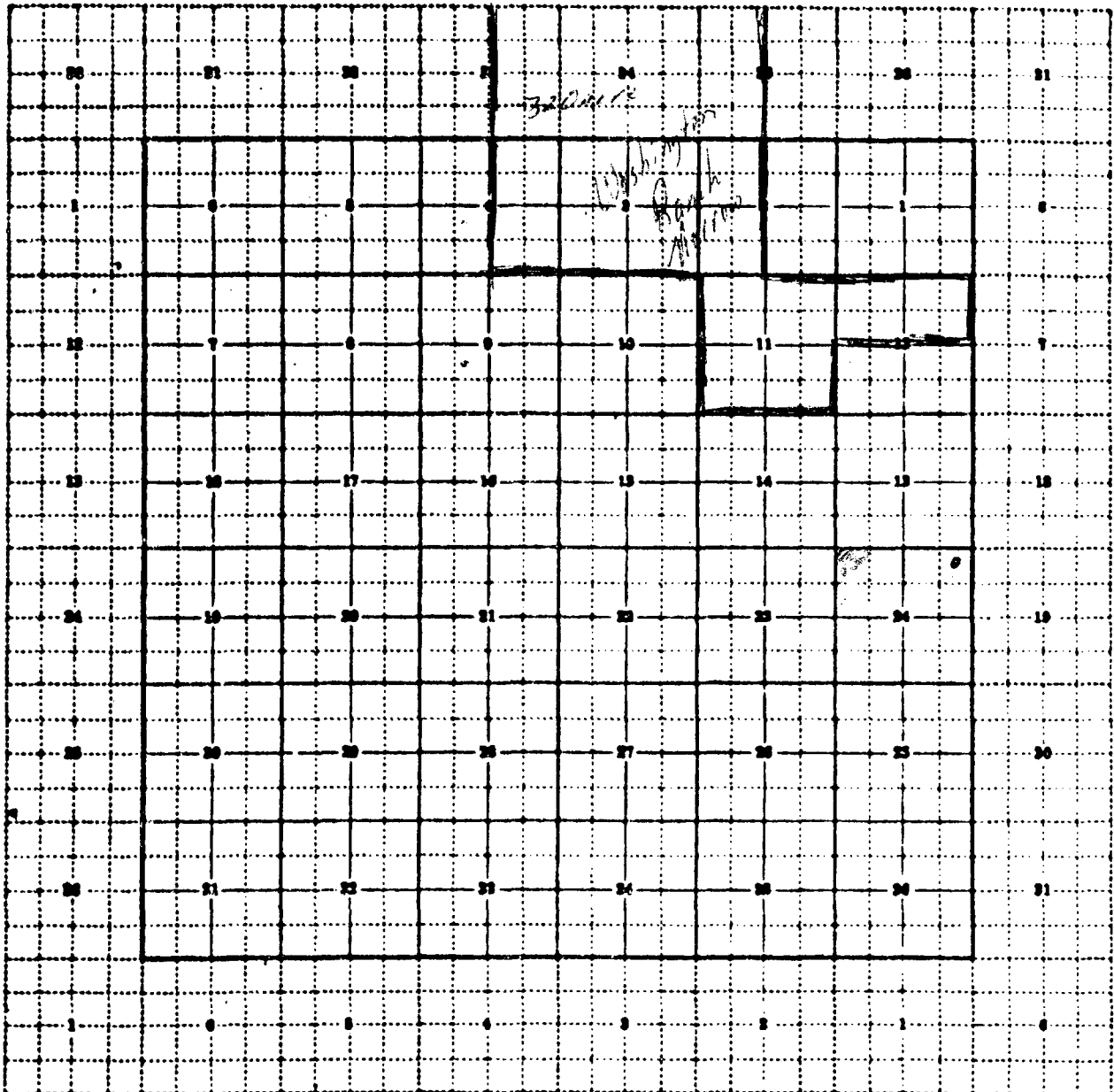
