APPLICATION

Santa Fe Energy Operating Partners, L.P., hereby makes application for an order pooling all interests from the surface to the base of the Bone Springs formation in the $SW_{4}^{1}SE_{4}^{1}$ of Section 14, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show:

- Applicant is a working interest owner in the SW4SE4 of said Section 14.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its Shinnery Federal Well No. 1 in the SWASEA of Section 14, at a location 660 feet from the south line and 1980 feet from the east line, to a depth of approximately 8800 feet or the base of the Bone formation, and seeks to dedicate the SWASEA of Section 14 to the well.
- Applicant has in good faith sought to join all other mineral interest owners in the SWASEA of Section 14 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although Applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have refused to join in dedicating their acreage. Therefore, Applicant seeks an order

pooling all mineral interest owners underlying the SW4SE4 of Section 14, pursuant to N.M. Stat. Ann. § 70-2-17 (1987 Repl.).

- 5. Applicant requests the Division to consider the cost of drilling and completing the well, the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision. Applicant requests that it be designated as operator of the well and that the Division set a penalty of 200% for the risk involved in drilling the well.
- 6. The pooling of all interests underlying the SW\(\frac{1}{4}\) Section 14 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.
- 7. Applicant requests that this matter be heard at the July 20, 1988 Examiner hearing.
