

On June 10, 1991 the Division entered the above-referenced Order granting the application of Collins & Ware, Inc., for compulsory pooling of the S/2 of Section 13, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This Order provided that Collins & Ware should commence the drilling of the proposed well in the S/2 of Section 13 on or before the 15th day of August, 1991 or, obtain an extension of time from the Division for good cause shown.


The proposed well is located within the Potash area and we have been advised by the Bureau of Land Management that "extra time will be needed to get approval for the application for permit to drill". See attached letter dated June 28, 1991 from the Bureau of Land Management.

Because of this delay in obtaining a permit to drill, it is essential that Collins & Ware, seek a sixty (60) day extension and that Order No. R-9523 be amended to provide that the drilling of a well in the S/2 of Section 13, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico be commenced on or before the 15th day of October, 1991.

Gentlemen:

This correspondence is in response to your application of May 31, 1991, requesting suspension of drilling operations for lease NM-43561 which falls within Noranda Exploration, Inc.'s Life of Mine Reserves ("LMR") boundary in the Secretary's Potash Area.

Lease NM-43561 of only 40 acres embraces the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, T. 20 S., R. 33 E., Lea County, New Mexico, and has a primary term expiration date of July 31, 1991. It is our understanding that your plan to communitize lease NM-43561 with a nearby lease LC-065447 following the drilling of a 14,000' well on the nearby lease which is also in the Potash Area.

An APD for the 14,000' Sharp Nose Federal No. 1, for which a 320 acres will be dedicated, in SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T. 20 S., R. 33 E., on the nearby lease LC-065447, was filed on May 28, 1991, with BLM. This APD is being evaluated for approval.

However, an extra time will be needed to get approval for an application for a permit to drill (APD) within the Potash Area. Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of 43 CFR 3103.4-2, approval of suspension of operations on lease NM-43561, is granted. The suspension is effective July 1, and shall expire October 31, 1991. The lease term will then expire 30 days from termination of lease suspension.
