



STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Meridian Oil Inc., Applicant, seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Delaware formation or to a depth of 8700 feet, whichever is deeper, underlying the SW/4 NW/4 (Unit E) of Section 23 Township 22 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit within said vertical extent. Said unit is to be dedicated to its Red Tank #1 Well to be drilled at a standard location thereon. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as the operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well.




