BTA hereby requests a hearing date of 3-17-94 to present evidence to substantiate our belief that the above referenced wells produce from two different Atoka reservoirs and to request an exception to Rule 104.C(2) to allow simultaneous dedication of the existing 320 acre gas spacing and proration unit.

The Hudson State #2 was recompleted as an Atoka producer on 11-16-93. The Hudson State #1-Y was Shut-In on 11-15-93, per Administrative Order NSL-3125-A.

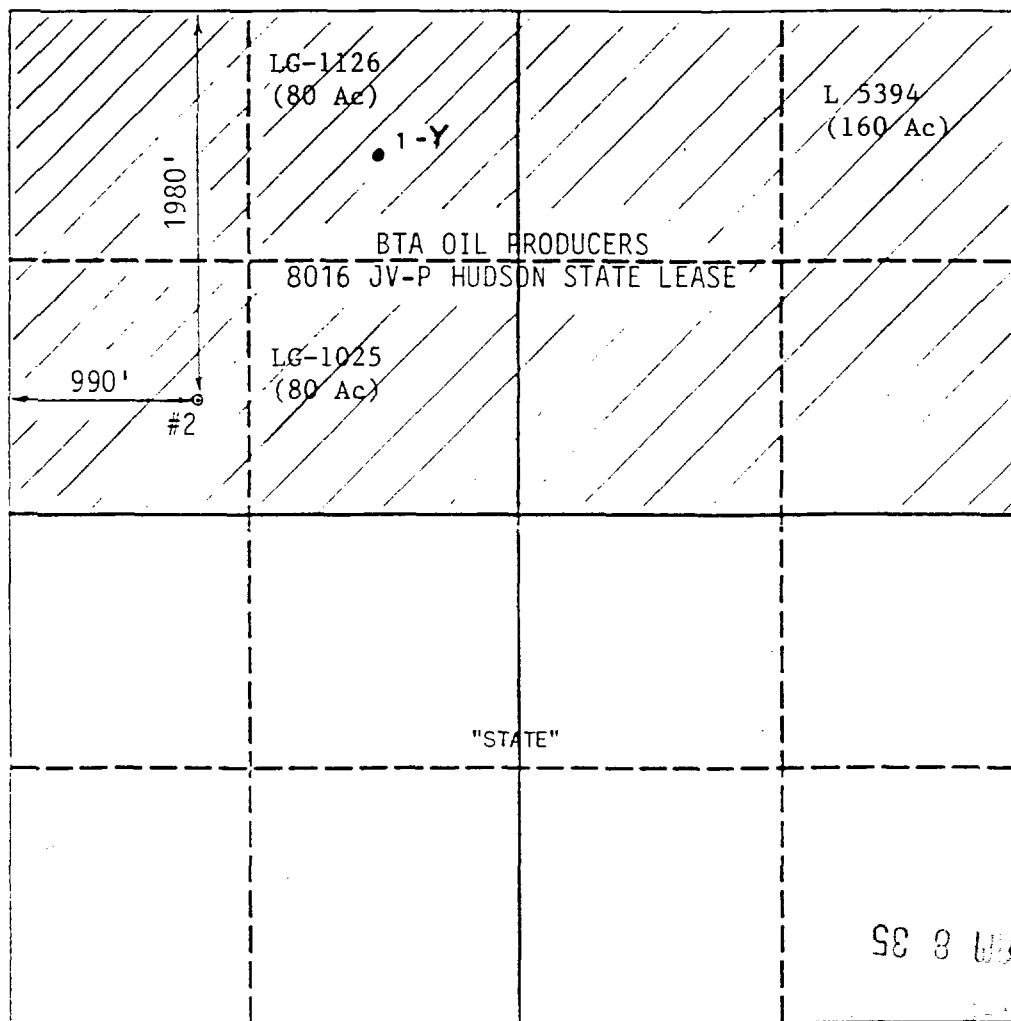

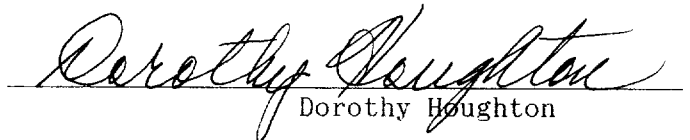

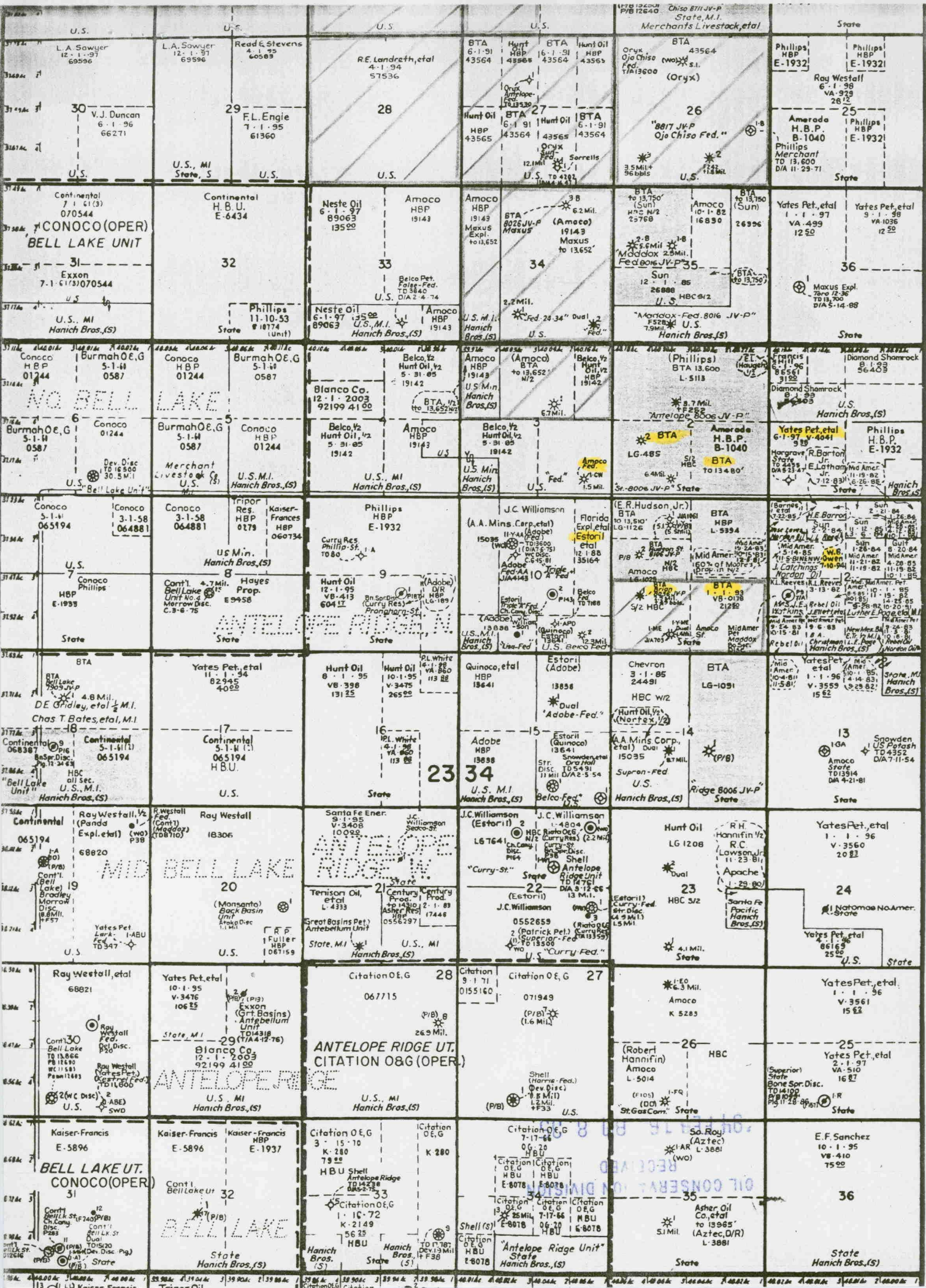
