APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company hereby makes application for an unorthodox gas well location in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 16 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is an interest owner and has the right to drill a well in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 26.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its Vandagriff "26" Fed. Well No. 1 in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, at an unorthodox location 1667 feet from the North line and 2140 feet from the West line of the Section, to a depth sufficient to test the Queen formation [Undesignated Vandagriff-Keyes Gas Pool (Queen)], and seeks to dedicate the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26 to the well.

3. The unorthodox location is necessitated by topographic, archaeologic, and geologic factors.

4. Approval of the unorthodox gas well location will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that the Division grant the relief requested above.


