APPLICATION

Comes now Blanks Energy Corporation through its attorneys and respectfully requests approval of an unorthodox oil well location, Lea County, New Mexico and in support thereof, states as follows:

1. Applicant is operator with interests underlying E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M, Vacuum South Devonian Field, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. Applicant wishes to drill an unorthodox oil well to test the Devonian Formation underlying said E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21 at a location 660 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line of said Section 21.
3. Applicant proposes to dedicate said E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21 to said well, with the well to be known as Blanks Energy Corporation's Honeysuckle No. 2 Well.
4. A well at said unorthodox location will better enable the Applicant to produce oil underlying the proration unit.
5. Approval of the unorthodox location will be in the interests of conservation, prevention of waste and protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this case be set for hearing on the July 25, 1984 docket.
