THE APPLICATION OF HOLLAND
INC. FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

OF THE SANTA FE AREA

Under the provisions of the Santa Fe Act, the applicant made application to the Santa Fe Commission on November 20, 1980, for a dual completion of Com No. 1 located in the Santa Fe Range 28 East, NMEP, to permit production of oil and gas from the Santa Fe Formation.

MMOCD Order R-6347 approved an unorthodox Morrow gas well location for the subject well 660 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line of Sec. 14, T.18S. R. 28E., Eddy County, New Mexico, the E/2 Sec. 14 being dedicated to the well.

Also, Holly Energy Inc., respectively seeks approval for the dual completion of the subject well of oil from the Travis---Upper Penn Pool (ext.) and gas from the South Empire---Morrow Pool (Ext.)
