
The purpose of this letter is to request a Permit for a Non-Standard Oil Well Location for Red Mountain Associates State No. 23 Well, located 660 feet from the North line and 2635 feet from the East line of Section 28, Township 20 North, Range 9 West, McKinley County, New Mexico.

Well #23 was drilled by Red Mountain Associates in June of 1981, the Well conforms to the spacing pattern established for the Chaco Wash Pool by Oil Conservation Division Order No. R-6538.

It is our intention to apply for an expansion of this Water Flood Project in the immediate future. We therefore respectfully request your approval of the Non-Standard Location, as it will conform to the established pattern.
