A P P L I C A T I O N

COMES NOW, Phillips Petroleum Company, by and through its attorneys, Kellahin & Kellahin, and apply to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for approval of an unorthodox oil well location 330 feet from the North line and 2580 feet from the West line of Section 23, T17S, R29E, NMPM, Grayburg Jackson Field, Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show:

1. Applicant has the right to drill and develop the NE/4NW/4 of Section 23, T17S, R29E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its Burch-C Federal Well No. 45 at an unorthodox oil well location 330 feet from the North Line and 2580 feet from the West line of Section 23, T17S, R29E, NMPM.

3. Applicant proposes to dedicate the NE/4NW/4 of said Section 23 to the well.

4. Applicant proposes to attempt a completion in the Grayburg-Jackson Pool.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing and that after notice and hearing the application be granted as requested.

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
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
