

MEMORANDUM

TO: ALL GAS PRODUCERS AND PURCHASERS
FROM: R. L. STAMETS, DIRECTOR 
SUBJECT: MORATORIUM FROM SHUT-IN, OVERPRODUCED WELLS

Upon a request and a showing that a high-demand emergency exists and under the authority granted the Division Director, pursuant to Rule 15(G) of the General Rules and Regulations For Prorated Gas Pools, a pool-wide moratorium from shut-in for wells for reasons of overproduction is hereby placed in effect.

The moratorium shall apply in the following described pools for the months of January through March, 1985:

Basin-Dakota, Blanco-Mesaverde, South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs, Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs, Blinebry, Burton Flat-Morrow, Eumont, Jalmat, Justis, and Tubb.

All parties should note that no extention of this moratorium may be made except after notice and hearing. Any such request should be made by March 4, 1985. It should further be noted that overproduction and underproduction will continue to accrue during this three-month period and wells may thereafter be required to be shut-in as provided in Rule 15(A) and 15(B) of said General Rules.
