When submitting your agreement for final approval please submit the following:

- 1. Application for formal approval by the Commissioner setting forth the tracts that have been committed and the tracts that have not been committed.
- 2. All ratifications from the lessees of Record and Working Interest Owners. All signatures should be acknowledged by a notary and one set must contain original signatures.
- 3. Order of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division. Our approval will be conditioned upon subsequent favorable approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.
- 4. Geological report and engineering data.
- 5. The filing fee for a unit agreement is thirty dollars per

section or partial thereof. Please submit a filing fee in the amount of \$210.00.

This office is also in receipt of your letter of June 10, 1988, together with some replacement pages which corrected an outer in the description of tract No. 5 and an error in the state lesse number of tract No. 12. These replacement pages have been excepted and filed in our unit files.

Our preliminary approval is also contingent upon you substiting the geological information as outlined in your letter to June 10, 1986.
