

AMENDED APPLICATION

Comes now, MOBIL PRODUCING TEXAS AND NEW MEXICO, INC., by and through its undersigned attorneys, and hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for an unorthodox oil well location, and in support thereof would show the Division:

1. Applicant is the operator of the Grayburg-San Andres formation underlying Lot 15 of Section 4, Township 16 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., and proposes to drill its Federal CCC Well No. 2 at a point 2970 feet from the South line and 2410 feet from the East line of said Section 4.

2. Applicant seeks an exception to the well location requirements of Rule 104 C I of the Oil Conservation Division to permit the drilling of the well at the above-mentioned unorthodox location to a depth sufficient to adequately test all formations to a depth of 3650 feet.

3. That a standard 40-acre oil proration unit comprising Lot 15 of said Section 4 should be dedicated to the Federal CCC Well No. 2.

4. That approval of this application will afford applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of oil in


the Northeast Square Lake Grayburg-San Andres Pool and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on July 9, 1986, that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division, that the Division enter its order approving the unorthodox location of the Federal CCC Well No. 2, and providing such other and further relief as is proper in the premises.
