
Dear Robert:

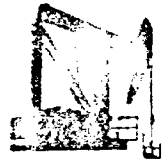
