Q Would you then just briefly summarize the history of this well?

A This well was spudded in March of 1983 and was TD'ed at a depth of 2639 feet on April 12th, 1983.

Completion attempts have been made on

A I prefer to wait for time for a contract because a lot will depend on much casing can be pulled out of it.

Q Okay. Do you have anything further in this case?
