RE: Application for an Unorthodox Gas Well Location for the Meyers A-1 Well No. 19, 1980' FNL - 890' FEL (Unit H) of Section 18, T-21S, R-36E, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Dear Mr. Irelan:

In reviewing the subject application, it was found that this well is within an existing 440-acre non-standard Eumont Gas proration and spacing unit, authorized by Division Order No. R-6141, dated October 12, 1979, comprising the following described acreage:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM

Section 17: SW/4, S/2 NW/4

Section 18: N/2 NE/4, SE/4 NE/4, and N/2 SE/4.

Said Order No. R-6141 also authorized the simultaneous dedication of this unit to the following wells all at unorthodox locations:

Meyer A-1 Well No. 11, 1980' FS&WL (Unit K), Section 17

Meyer A-1 Well No. 6 660' FNL - 1980' FEL (Unit B), Section 16

Meyer A-1 Well No. 14, 1980' FS&EL (Unit L), Section 16

The Meyer A-1 Well No. 14 was converted to a Eunice Monument Gb/SA South Unit Well in December 1986.

Your application also stated that the subject well is a replacement for the former Meyer A-1 Well No. 8 (Chevron's Eunice Monument South Unit Well No. 376), located 1980' FNL and 660' FEL (Unit H) of said Section 16. Our records show that the No. 8 well was never completed in the Eumont Gas Pool.

Per my telephone conversation on Friday October 23, 1987 with Hugh Ingram and Ann Bullion of your office, this application is being set for hearing on November 18, 1987 to amend said Order No. R-6141 to include this well in this existing non-standard gas proration unit that straddles a section line and has presently dedicated to it two unorthodox wells. The Division feels this hearing is necessary because of all of the infractions that exist within this unit and since all previous exceptions required a hearing in the first place.
