POOLS IN EDDY AND CHAVES COUNTIES,
NEW MEXICO.

NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-8562 dated December 4, 1987, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Finding Paragraph No. (6) on page 2 of Order No. R-8562 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(6) There is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Bone Spring formation, said pool to bear the designation of West Lusk-Bone Spring Pool. Said West Lusk-Bone Spring Pool was discovered by the Damson Oil Corporation Dozier Federal Com Well No. 1 located in Unit K of Section 14, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Bone Spring formation on July 24, 1987. The top of the perforations is at 7,976 feet."

(2) Paragraph (e) on page 3 of said Order No. R-8562 be and the same is hereby corrected to read in its entirety as follows:


"(e) A new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Bone Spring production is hereby created and designated as the West Lusk-Bone Spring Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM
Section 14: SW/4"


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(3) The corrections set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of December 4, 1987.
