Q Would you please state your name, by
whom you're employed, and in what capacity?

A My name is Roy Johnson. I'm employed by
the State of New Mexico, Oil Conservation Division, as
Senior Geologist.

Q Have you previously testified before the
Commission and had your qualifications accepted?

A They have

Q Are you prepared to make recommendations
to the Examiner concerning the nomenclature of certain
pools in Lea County, New Mexico?

A I am.

MR. STOVALL: I'd first ask
that the witness be accepted.

MR. CATANACH: He is so
qualified.

Q Are your recommendations prepared in the
form of an exhibit?

A They are.

1 Q And how is that exhibit identified?

2 A As Exhibit One. Both of them are as

14 exhibits prepared by you or under your supervision and do
15 you have knowledge of its accuracy?

16 A Yes.

17 Q Do you have anything further to add in
18 these cases?

19 A Nothing at all.
