9 Commission or its examiners and had your credentials ac-

12 Q Are you prepared to make recommendations
13 to the Examiner today concerning the nomenclature of cer-
14 tain pools in Chaves and Eddy Counties, New Mexico?

15 A I am.

16 Q And are your recommendations prepared
17 in the form of an exhibit?18 A They are. The exhibit is labeled Exhi-
19 bit Number One.20 Q And would you please refer to Exhibit
21 Number One and to the docket that's been distributed for
22 the hearing today and -- and identify any differences be-
23 tween the two, if there are any?24 A There are no differences between the

1 and (h) be dismissed.
