ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on September 23, 1993, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 1st day of October, 1993, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) There is need for certain extensions to the Alamito-Gallup Oil Pool in Sandoval County, New Mexico, the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Lybrook-Gallup Oil Pool, both in Rio Arriba, Sandoval, and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Otero-Chacra Pool, both in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, the South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool, the Gavilan Greenhorn-Graneros-Dakota Oil Pool, and the Largo-Gallup Pool, all in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, the Flora Vista-Fruitland Sand Pool, the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Gallegos-Gallup Associated Pool, the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, the Kutz-Gallup Oil Pool, and the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, all in San Juan County, New Mexico.

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(3) The effective date of this order and all extensions included herein should be October 1, 1993.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

(1) Pursuant to Section 70-2-18, NMSA 1978, contained in Chapter 271, Laws of 1969, any well which, by virtue of any of the above pool extensions, is subject to pool rules providing for spacing or proration units larger than the one which is presently dedicated thereto, shall have 60 days from the effective date of this order in which to file new Forms C-102 dedicating a standard unit for the pool to said well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division. Pending such compliance, the well shall receive a maximum allowable in the same proportion to a standard allowable for the pool that the acreage dedicated to the well bears to a standard unit for the pool. Failure to file Form C-102 dedicating a standard unit to the well or to obtain a non-standard unit approved by the Division within said 60-day period shall subject the well to cancellation of allowable.

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(2) The effective date of this order and all extensions included herein shall be October 1, 1993.
