

On July 8, 1976, Northwest Pipeline Corporation, as Unit Operator, filed an Application for the Amended Initial Expanded Participating Area and the First and Second Expansions of the Participating Area for the Dakota formation in the San Juan 30-5 Unit. These applications were approved by the Commissioner of Public Lands on July 19, 1976, and the Oil Conservation Commission on July 27, 1976. By letter dated October 15, 1976, the United States Geological Survey recommended the Initial Participating Area for the Dakota embracing the W/2 of Section 8, Township 30 North, Range 5 West, effective January 1, 1974, remain unchanged and the Initial Dakota Participating Area "A" be formed based on the Coastline Petroleum No. 1-57 Schalk well located in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 12, Township 30 North, Range 5 West. By letter of January 7, 1977, the United States Geological Survey recommended the First and Second Expansions for the Dakota Participating Area be deferred until Wells No. 39 and 47 are connected for determination of which lands should be included. Northwest Pipeline Corporation, as Operator, and the majority of the Dakota working interest owners, concur in these recommendations.

Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of Section 11 (b) of the San Juan 30-5 Unit Agreement #14-08-001-436, approved November 7, 1952, Northwest Pipeline Corporation, as Unit Operator, hereby respectfully requests approval of the Initial Dakota Participating Area "A", to wit:

This proposed Initial Dakota Participating Area "A" is predicated upon the determination by Northwest Pipeline Corporation that the Coastline Petroleum No. 1-57 Schalk well, drilled and completed outside the limits of the present Dakota Participating Area, is capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Dakota formation.

Pertinent well data for the No. 1-57 Schalk well is as follows:

The Coastline Petroleum #1-57 Schalk well is located 790' from the North Line and 1650' from the West Line of Section 12, Township 30 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The well is situated in a communitized drilling block in the N/2 of Section 12, which includes 68.63 acres of unit land. The well was spudded on March 31, 1973, and completed at a total depth of 8222' on July 19, 1973. The Dakota Producing Interval was perforated with two shots per foot as follows: 8010'-8024', 8056'-8066', 8080'-8114', 8141'-8162', and 8176'-8190'. The perforations were hydraulically fractured with a mixture of 200,000 gallons of water and 100,000 pounds of sand. The well was flowed for four (4) hours on a back pressure test July 19, 1973. The Absolute Open Flow potential was 5147 MCF/D with a SIPT of 2922 psia and SIPC of 2947 psia. On the basis of this well, Lots 1 and 2 and the SW/4 of the NE/4 of Section 12 are now recommended for inclusion in the Initial Dakota Participating Area "A".
