Pursuant to Section 11(a) of the San Juan 32-8 Unit Agreement, Northwest Pipeline Corporation, as Unit Operator, determined on the date indicated below that the San Juan 32-8 Unit Well No. 36 was capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Fruitland formation and was completed on a drilling block committed to this Unit which should create the Initial Participating Area for the Fruitland as follows:

> The San Juan 32-8 Unit No. 36 well is located 1640 feet from the North Line and 1710 feet from the East Line, Section 25, Township 32 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. This well was spudded on October 2, 1976 and completed on November 30, 1976 in the North Los Pinos Fruitland Formation at a plug back depth of 4017'. The Fruitland Formation was perforated with one hole at each of the following depths: 3773', 3777', 3783', 3787', 3797', 3802', 3829'. These perforations were treated with 15% HCL followed by a sand-water fracturing. The well was shut-in October 13, 1976 for 43 days with a SIPC of 1493 psig. On November 30, 1976, the well was tested through the casing and after flowing for three (3) hours through a 3/4" variable choke on the 8 5/8" casing, the well gauged 1049 MCFD with a calculated AOF of 1054 MCFD. From April 1, 1977 through August 31, 1977, this well has produced 58,277 MCFG.

Attached are Schedule I and ownership map showing the Initial Participating Area for the Fruitland formation of the San Juan 32-8 Unit. The Schedule describes the Initial Participating Area and shows the percentage of unitized substances allocated to the drilling block tract. Inasmuch as this needs no official approval, no provision is made therefor and in the absence of disapproval the captioned Initial Participating Area will become effective November 30, 1976.
