

AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION

For the consideration stated therein, the undersigned SINCLAIR OIL & GAS COMPANY, a Maine corporation, hereby ratifies, confirms and joins in the execution of the Unit Agreement for the Development and Operation of the Drickey Queen Sand Unit, Caprock Field, Chaves County, New Mexico, approved by the Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico, and also on the 22nd day of September, 1959, by the Director of the United States Geological Survey, and further ratifies, confirms and joins in the execution of Unit Operating Agreement, Drickey Queen Sand Unit, Caprock Field, Chaves County, New Mexico, entered into concurrently with the Unit Agreement.

The undersigned represents that its interests in the Unit Area are as follows:

1. An overriding royalty interest of 3.13% in Tract No. 22, NW/4 of the NE/4, Section 16, T-14-S, R-31-E, as set forth in revised Exhibit "B" of said Unit Agreement;
2. An overriding royalty interest of 10.94% in Tract No. 11, W/2 of the E/2, Section 11, T-14-S, R-31-E, as set forth in revised Exhibit "B" of said Unit Agreement;
3. A working interest of 87.5% in the NE/4 of the NE/4 and the SE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 11, T-14-S, R-31-E, which should be listed and shown in a further revision of Exhibit "B" of said Unit Agreement, as a separately numbered tract with its participation calculated on the basis prescribed in Section 13 of the Unit Agreement which is the same basis as for those tracts heretofore qualifying for participation in the Unit Area.

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company represents that it has heretofore secured consent to its execution of said Unit Agreement and Unit Operating

Agreement from the owners of production payment under the terms and provisions of the Indenture of Conveyance of Leasehold, Mineral and Other Interests and Retention of Production Payment dated March 23, 1955, between Alban Corporation and Sinclair Oil & Gas Company, and of the Holder of the Notes and of the Trustee under the provisions of a Mortgage and Deed of Trust dated March 23, 1955, between H. D. S. Eastern Corporation, et al, and Donald Scott, Jr., Trustee, insofar, and only insofar, as concerns the interests hereinabove described in paragraphs 2 and 3.

In connection with the above units, and more specifically the problem of deleting the Gulf-Browning and Ambassador-State lands from the Drickey Queen Sand Unit area and the inclusion thereof within the Rock Queen Unit, we hand you herewith an original and one copy of the form of proposed Amendment To The Unit Agreement For The Development And Operation Of The Drickey Queen Sand Unit, which form has heretofore been approved by Mr. Wilkinton of the Washington office, U. S. Geological Survey.

In line with our agreement with Mr. Gene Funk of Cities Service Oil Company, Bartlesville, Oklahoma, will you please have one of the enclosed forms prepared and forward them to Mr. Funk, sending one copy thereof to us; we will rely upon your office to check the form as to clerical errors rather than request it be returned to us, and this of course will expedite the matter.

It is our understanding that the following procedures will be conducted in connection with the above "contraction and expansion".

1. Upon receipt of the Amendments, Mr. Funk will prepare an appropriate cover letter addressed to the Working Interest Owners in the Drickey Unit, and circulate it together with approximately eleven copies of the Amendment to each Working Interest party who has signed the Drickey Queen Sand Unit Agreement. The letter will request the return of nine copies of the Amendment.

2. Simultaneously with the transmittal material in (1) above, Mr. Funk will prepare and forward to each Royalty Owner in the Drickey Unit who has signed said Unit Agreement, a letter advising of the aforementioned "contraction", deleting the NW¹ Section 34 and NE¹ NW¹ Section 35, T. 13 S., R. 31 E., N.M.P.M. from the Drickey Queen Sand Unit area.

3. Mr. Funk will advise the Director, the Commissioner and the Commission of the mailings in (1) and (2) above. These transmittals will request the approval of the Commission and the Commissioner to the "contraction" (it is our understanding that the Commissioner's approval is limited to the committed lands and that the Commission's order of approval deletes the afordescribed lands); thus, it appears that the Commissioner and the Commission have already indicated their approval to this "contraction".

4. Approximately ten days after the mailings in (1) above, you should contact Mr. Funk to determine which of the Working Interest Owners have not returned the signed Amendments to Cities Service. You should then take the initiative in obtaining the remaining required signatures, being certain that each party returns to Cities Service (or delivers to you for transmittal) nine counterparts of the Amendment.

5. When each Working Interest Owner has signed the Amendment, Cities Service will deliver the various counterparts to us, and we will undertake the appropriate distribution thereof, which we understand to be:

(a) Five counterparts to the Director of U. S. Geological Survey, directly to Mr. Pilkinton, but with notification to the Supervisor at Roswell, New Mexico.

(b) Two counterparts to the Commissioner.

(c) One counterpart to the Commission.

(d) One counterpart to (or to be retained by) Cities Service.

It is our understanding that the aforementioned procedures will not, in any way, delay the approval by the Director of the Dickey Queen Sand Unit Agreement, and the enclosed Amendment contemplates such prior approval.

The other matters to be handled by this office concerning the Rock Queen Unit, as discussed by the writer with your Mr. Wilson, will be forthcoming at an early date.

Gentlemen:

Cities Service, as Operator for the proposed Drickey Queen Sand Unit, has submitted executed agreements and related data for final Government approval.

A New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission hearing was held August 19, 1959, and we expect their order to be issued within a few days. The New Mexico State Land Commission has issued a certificate accepting unitization of the qualifying tracts. We submitted the executed agreements and above mentioned certificate to the U.S.G.S. in Roswell, New Mexico, August 20, 1959. They asked for certain supplemental data and on September 4, 1959, forwarded the agreements, etc., to the Department of Interior in Washington, with their recommendation on approval. We are hopeful that the Federal Certificate, approving the unit, will be signed and returned to us in time to file for record before October 1, 1959, and thereby make the unit effective on that date.

In anticipation that the unit can be declared in effect October 1, 1959, we are hereby calling a meeting of Working Interest Owners for 10:00 A.M. (Mountain Time) September 24, 1959, to be held in the Cities Service Division Office, Hobbs, New Mexico. The office is located about one mile west of town on Highway 62. The agenda for this meeting is as follows:

1. Arrange for transfer of operations from the several present operators to Unit Operator.
2. Agree on uniform method for handling oil in tanks as of effective date to comply with Section 12 of Operating Agreement.
3. Plan for inventory of equipment and pricing of materials for investment adjustment.

4. Consider unit acquisition of general facilities provided for in Paragraph 10.4 of the Operating Agreement. The chief item for consideration here is the Cities Service waterflood system.

5. Review plans for initial and subsequent waterflood development.

6. Any other matters necessary to commence operation as a unit.

Enclosed is a tabulation showing the recalculation of participation to eliminate tracts which do not qualify for inclusion at this time. Conformed copies of the Unit Agreements will be supplied as soon as possible.


Also enclosed, or forwarded under separate cover to lease operators only, are suggested inventory forms which we desire to have worked up by present lease owners for down the hole equipment. Please bring these filled in inventory sheets to the meeting or mail to Mr. C. H. Whittington in our Bartlesville Office in time to reach him on or before September 22. For our records, as Unit Operator, we also ask that present lease operators send us copies of the official State well logs and reports of any recompletion or remedial work on their wells.

In planning for the inventory, it is requested that representatives attending the meeting be prepared to state if they will have inventory men to work with the Cities Service inventory crew, how many they can supply and if they will work on the entire inventory or for only their own leases.

As we have stated previously, we are anxious to put the unit into effect because our Government "B" pilot flood is giving a good response. We realize that the Department of Interior may not act in time to make the unit effective October 1, 1959, but plans made at the coming meeting should be equally applicable for a later date.

This meeting call is being directed to all Working Interest Owners in qualifying tracts as well as to several other interested parties. In accordance with Section 4.1 of the Unit Operating Agreement, each Working Interest owner is to notify the Unit Operator, in writing, the name and address of its representative. We would appreciate receiving this notification by the time of the September 24, meeting.
