There are currently 12 active producing wells, 3 shut-in producing wells, and 3 active injection wells on the Unit. During 1985, 1 producing well was acidized resulting in a production increase from 2 BOPD to 5.8 BOPD.

The Unit averaged 21.3 BOPD, 2.3 MCFD, and 92.3 BWPD production during 1985. Average water injection was 92.3 BWPD during 1985.

This Plan of Operation may be modified from time to time with the approval of the Bureau of Land Management to meet changing conditions.



- 4.3.3 <u>Vote at Meeting by Nonattending Working Interest Owner</u>. Any Working Interest Owner not represented at a meeting may vote on any item included in the agenda of the meeting by letter or telegram addressed to the chairman of the meeting, provided such vote is received prior to the submission of such item to vote. Such vote shall not be counted with respect to any item on the agenda which is amended at the meeting.
- 4.3.4 <u>Poll Votes</u>. Working Interest Owners may decide any matter by vote taken by letter or telegram, provided the matter is first submitted in writing to each Working Interest Owner and no meeting on the matter is called as provided in Article 4.2 within seven (7) days after such proposal is served on Working Interest Owners. Unit Operator will give prompt notice of the results of such voting to all Working Interest Owners.

ARTICLE 5

INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF WORKING INTEREST OWNERS

- 5.1 Reservation of Rights. Working Interest Owners severally reserve to themselves all their rights, power, authority and privileges, except as provided expressly in this Agreement and the Unit Agreement.
- 5.2 <u>Specific Rights</u>. Each Working Interest Owner shall have, among others, the following specific rights and privileges:
 - 5.2.1 Access to Unit Area. Access to the Unit Area at all reasonable times to inspect the operation hereunder and all wells and records and data pertaining thereto.
 - 5.2.2 Reports by Request. The right to receive from Unit Operator, upon written request, copies of all reports to any governmental agency, reports of crude cil runs and stocks, inventory reports and all other data not ordinarily furnished by Unit Operator to all Working Interest Owners; the cost of preparing copies of said reports shall be charged solely to the Working Interest Owners requesting the same.
- 5.3 <u>Undrilled Locations</u>. Undrilled locations on tracts committed to the Unit Area shall be drilled by the Unit Operator at Unit expense.

- 4.3.3 <u>Vote at Meeting by Nonattending Working Interest Owner</u>. Any Working Interest Owner not represented at a meeting may vote on any item included in the agenda of the meeting by letter or telegram addressed to the chairman of the meeting, provided such vote is received prior to the submission of such item to vote. Such vote shall not be counted with respect to any item on the agenda which is amended at the meeting.
- 4.3.4 <u>Poll Votes</u>. Working Interest Owners may decide any matter by vote taken by letter or telegram, provided the matter is first submitted in writing to each Working Interest Owner and no meeting on the matter is called as provided in Article 4.2 within seven (7) days after such proposal is served on Working Interest Owners. Unit Operator will give prompt notice of the results of such voting to all Working Interest Owners.

ARTICLE 5

INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF WORKING INTEREST OWNERS

- 5.1 <u>Reservation of Rights</u>. Working Interest Owners severally reserve to themselves all their rights, power, authority and privileges, except as provided expressly in this Agreement and the Unit Agreement.
- 5.2 <u>Specific Rights</u>. Each Working Interest Owner shall have, among others, the following specific rights and privileges:
 - 5.2.1 Access to Unit Area. Access to the Unit Area at all reasonable times to inspect the operation hereunder and all wells and records and data pertaining thereto.
 - 5.2.2 Reports by Request. The right to receive from Unit Operator, upon written request, copies of all reports to any governmental agency, reports of crude oil runs and stocks, inventory reports and all other data not ordinarily furnished by Unit Operator to all Working Interest Owners; the cost of preparing copies of said reports shall be charged solely to the Working Interest Owners requesting the same.
- 5.3 <u>Undrilled Locations</u>. Undrilled locations on tracts committed to the Unit Area shall be drilled by the Unit Operator at Unit expense.

AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 11 OF THE GRAYBURG-JACKSON SAND UNIT AGREEMENT WE WISH TO OFFER THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION WHICH DESCRIBES THE INITIAL PLAN OF WATERFLOOD OPERATION IN THE PROPOSED UNIT:

A DOUBLE FIVE-SPOT PILOT WATER FLOOD WILL BE INSTALLED UTILIZING SIX (6) INJECTION WELLS WHICH HAVE BEEN CONNECTED BY A SOLID LINE ON THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A". WATER INJECTION RATES ARE ANTICIPATED TO BE 500 BARRELS PER DAY PER INJECTION WELL PRO-VIDED BY A WATER PRESSURING PLANT LOCATED ON TRACT 7. INJECTION WILL BE DOWN-HOLE THROUGH TUBING AND A PACKER WILL BE ATTACHED TO THE TUBING AND SET IN THE CASING NEAR THE BOTTOM POINT SO AS TO PROVIDE A POSITIVE SEAL AND INSURE THE INJECTION OF WATER INTO THE PAY SECTION. THE WATER FOR INJECTION WILL BE PURCHASED FROM THE CAPROCK WATER COMPANY, A COMMERCIAL COMPANY OPERATING IN THE AREA. THE WATER WILL BE FRESH TO BRACKISH IN NATURE AND SHOULD BE OF EXCELLENT QUALITY FOR INJECTION PURPOSES.

FOLLOWING POSITIVE RESPONSE TO WATER INJECTION, AS INDICATED BY OIL PRODUCTION INCREASES EFFECTED AT WELLS SURROUNDING THESE IN-JECTION WELLS, THE ENTIRE UNIT WILL BE DEVELOPED BY EXTENSION OF A NORMAL FIVE-SPOT FLOOD PATTERN. OFFSET OPERATORS WHO HAVE WELLS PRODUCING FROM THE SAME RESERVOIR HAVE AGREED TO A COOPERATIVE FLOOD EFFORT ALONG THE UNIT BOUNDARY LINES WHICH WILL INSURE EFFICIENT AND EQUITABLE FLOODING ALONG THESE BOUNDARY LINES.
