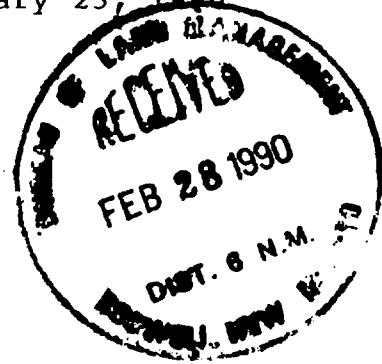

Marbob Energy Corporation as unit operator of the Square Lake 12 Unit submits this 1990 Plan of Operations on behalf of the working interest owners and in compliance with the Bureau of Land Management requirements.

There were no new wells drilled in 1989 and the status of all wells has remained the same throughout the year. Well numbers 101, 104, 106, 107, 108, 109, 111, 112, and 116 are pumping wells. Well number 224 is temporarily abandoned, and well numbers 100, 102, 105, 110, 115, and 117 are water injection wells.

It is anticipated for 1990 that all pumping and injection wells will have to be cleaned out and have scale inhibitor placed in them. There are no new wells planned at this time.

All working interest owners under the Square Lake 12 Unit have been provided with a copy of this Plan of Operations. Marbob Energy Corporation as unit operator, and the working interest owners believe that all current unit obligations and requirements have been met.

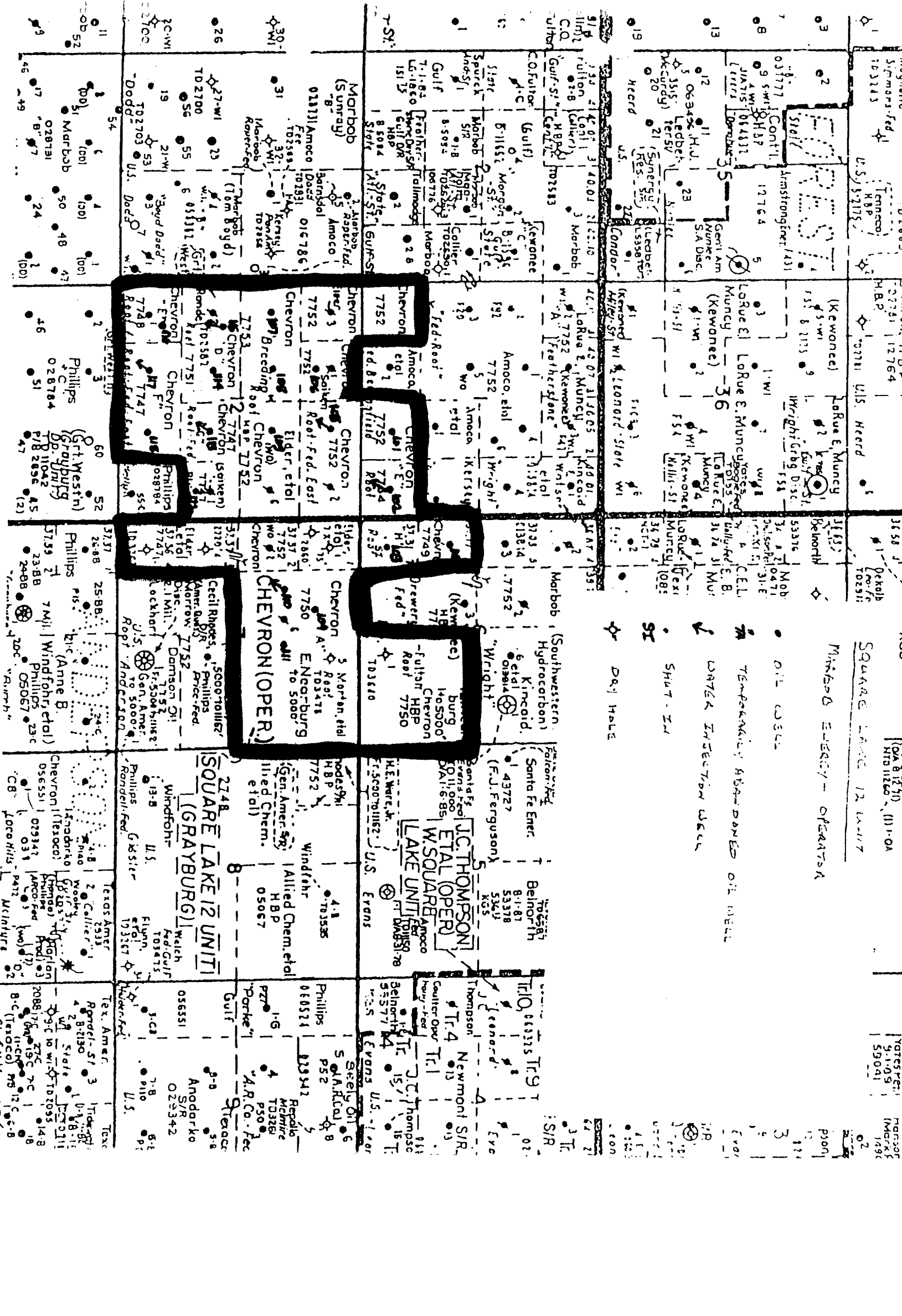
