A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now MIDWEST OIL CORPORATION by its attorneys and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for approval of the Little Inbe (Bough "C") Unit, Lea County, New Mexico and in support of its application states:

1. The proposed Little Inbe (Bough "C") Unit covers 2,240 acres of State of New Mexico lands, consisting of the E/2 of Section 10, and all of Sections 11, 14 and 15, T. 10 S., R. 33 E., N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant proposes to unitize the Bough "C" Formation within the proposed Unit area for the purpose of conducting a secondary recovery project therein by way of waterflood, all as set forth in a companion application.

3. Applicant will be designated as the Operator of the proposed Little Inbe (Bough "C") Unit Agreement.

4. Approval of the proposed Unit Agreement will facilitate development and operation of the proposed waterflood project and will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before the Commission or one of its examiners and that the Commission enter its order approving the proposed Little Inbe (Bough "C") Unit Agreement.
