Dear Ms. Atwater:

I am unable to administratively approve the two subject unorthodox oil well locations at this time. General Rule 104.F.I. and Ordering Paragraph No. (2) of Division Order No. R-2729, as amended, do not provide a provision for administrative review of producing wells drilled closer than 990 feet to the outer boundary of the West Pearl Queen Unit (see copies of Order Nos. R-2729, R-2729-A, and R-2728).

I have therefore set this filing to be heard before an Examiner at the next available hearing scheduled for April 18, 1990.
