TEXACO EXPLORATION AND PRODUCTION INC. ("Texaco") makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for Special Pool Rules and Regulations for the South Sand Dunes Bone Spring Pool, to include a gas-oil ratio of 10,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil produced, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is an operator of producing wells located in the South Sand Dunes Bone Spring Pool.

2. The South Sand Dunes Bone Spring Pool was created by Oil Conservation Division Order No. R-7419, dated January 1, 1984 and has been expanded from time to time to include the following described acreage:

Township 23 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 29: SW/4
Section 30: W/2, SE/4
Section 31: NW/4
Section 32: N/2
